Instructor Certification Pathways

There are two (2) pathways an IIPA Certified Iridologist can choose from to become an IIPA Certified Iridology Instructor. Both of these pathways require the following:

- To be an active Certified member of IIPA
- To have passed the IIPA Examination with a minimum of 90% in each section
- 1. For those Certified Iridologists that have *no* Iridology experience and *no* teaching experience, the requirements are:
 - Observe a Level I and Level II class with an IIPA Certified Instructor
 - Practice Iridology for 2 years and upon completion provide a signed Affidavit of that practice and evidence of a minimum of 50 Iridology Consultations
 - Conduct an on-site Instructor demonstration for Evaluation Committee (requires a completed Instructor Certification Application form with fee payment).
- 2. For those Certified Iridologists that have had Iridology experience and teaching experience, the requirements are:
 - Sign Affidavit for Iridology practice of 2 or more years of Iridology experience having conducted more than 50 Iridology Consultations.
 - Sign Affidavit for Instructor experience having conducted a minimum of 245 hours of instructing.
 - Conduct an on-site Instructor demonstration for Evaluation Committee (requires a completed Instructor Certification Application form with fee payment).

Upon completion of these requirements, an IIPA Certified Iridology Instructor will receive an IIPA Instructor Certificate.

For an IIPA Certified Iridology Instructor to maintain his/her Instructor status, an Instructor is required to maintain an active membership with IIPA and attend an IIPA Symposium Instructor Meeting every 2 (two) years.
